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Characteristics of Life

Growth, reproduction, metabolism, cellular organization, response to stimuli, homeostasis.

Metabolism + cellular organization: universal, non-negotiable defining features.

Taxonomic Hierarchy

Kingdom > Phylum/Division > Class > Order > Family > Genus > Species.

Nomenclature

Binomial nomenclature (Linnaeus): Genus+species, italicized.

Codes: ICBN/ICN (plants), ICZN (animals).

Taxonomical Aids

Herbarium, botanical gardens, museums, zoological parks, taxonomic keys.

One-Line Summary

The living world chapter defines what makes organisms “alive” and establishes the taxonomic hierarchy and binomial nomenclature system used to systematically classify and name Earth’s biodiversity.
