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Extra Questions for Class 1 Maths Chapter 11

Q1. If you add 4 three times ($4 + 4 + 4$), what is the total?

12.

Q2. There are 3 boxes with 5 jalebis in each box. How many jalebis are there in total?

$5 + 5 + 5 = 15$ jalebis.

Q3. Write “ $2 + 2 + 2 + 2$ ” using the word “times”.

4 times 2.

Q4. A bus has 4 rows with 2 seats in each row. How many seats are there in total?

$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 8$ seats.

Q5. If “3 times 3” means adding 3 three times, what is the total?

$3 + 3 + 3 = 9$.

Q6. There are 2 pencil boxes with 6 pencils in each. How many pencils in total?

$6 + 6 = 12$ pencils.

How to Use These Extra Questions
