Q4. Name one long thing you use to write.
Answers will vary — for example, a pencil, a pen, or a crayon.

Q5. If your friend's pencil reaches from your wrist to your fingertip, and yours reaches past your elbow, whose pencil is longer?
Yours is longer.

Q6. Is a clock (the round wall kind) long or round?
Round.

Q7. Is a cricket stump/wicket long or round?
Long.
