Extra Questions for Class 5 Maths Chapter 15

Q1. A pictograph shows 4 symbols for “apples”, and each symbol = 10 apples. How many apples in total?

40 apples.

Q2. If each symbol = 5 books and a bar shows 6 symbols, how many books is that?

30 books.

Q3. Which is generally easier to compare quickly: a pictograph or a bar chart?

Both work well, but **bar charts** are often quicker to compare heights at a glance.

Q4. If a toy shop sold 3 symbols worth of cars, and each symbol = 8 cars, how many cars were sold?

24 cars.

Q5. Why do pictographs need a key showing the value of each symbol?

Because without the key, **the number of symbols alone doesn't tell you the actual quantity.**
