Rs 1,725.

Q3. Is 4,368 an even or odd number?
Even (ends in 8).

Q4. A family climbs 1,240 m up a hill, then comes down 480 m to a rest point. What height are they at now?
760 m.

Q5. Round Rs 2,875 to the nearest hundred before estimating a shopping bill.
Rs 2,900.
