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Class 1 Maths Chapter 1 Revision Notes: Finding the Furry Cat!

Chapter type: Pre-number concepts (no numbers yet — this chapter builds the position vocabulary needed before children start counting and measuring).

Key position words to remember:

Inside / Outside — inside means within the boundary of something (like inside a house or inside a bag); outside means beyond that boundary.

Under / On — under means below and covered by something; on means resting on top of the surface of something.

Top / Bottom — top is the highest point or level; bottom is the lowest point or level.

Above / Beside — above means higher than, without necessarily touching; beside means next to, at the same level.

What you should be able to do after this chapter:

1. Look at a picture and correctly say whether an object is inside or outside something.
2. Use “under”, “on”, “top”, and “bottom” correctly when describing where something is.
3. Use “above” and “beside” correctly in a full sentence.
4. Play simple position-word games (like the IN/OUT ball toss) and use the correct word for each outcome.

Remember: This chapter has no numbers or counting — it is entirely about describing *where* something is, which is the groundwork for shapes, patterns, and measurement later in Class 1 Maths.
