What this chapter teaches.

Earth is the only known planet that supports life, providing air, water, and food for all living beings; how nature shows interconnectedness — migratory birds travel across countries, oceans link distant shores, and winds and clouds carry rain from one region to another; the idea of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam — “the world is one family,” meaning we should treat everyone and everything with kindness regardless of country or language; and our shared responsibility to care for the Earth’s resources.

Activity 1 — How Are We Connected?

Children think of examples of how people, animals, or resources in different places are connected — like a migratory bird, or a river flowing through many states.

Activity 2 — Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam in Action.

Children discuss what treating the world as “one family” means in practice, and suggest a kind action they could take for someone or something outside their immediate circle.

Activity 3 — My Earth Promise.

Children write a simple personal promise for how they will help take care of the Earth’s shared resources.
