## NCERT Solutions for Class 5 EVS Chapter 2: Journey of a River

### What this chapter teaches.

The three stages of a river's journey — the upper course (mountainous, where the river begins as a stream), the middle course (where tributaries join and the river widens), and the lower course (flowing slowly across plains before reaching the sea); key river vocabulary — source (where a river begins), tributary (a smaller stream joining a larger river), and mouth (where a river meets the sea); and the real journey of the Godavari River, which begins at Trimbakeshwar in Maharashtra and flows through Maharashtra, Telangana, Chhattisgarh, and Andhra Pradesh before reaching the Bay of Bengal.

### Activity 1 — Trace the Godavari.

Children trace the Godavari's path on a map, marking its source, the states it passes through, and its mouth.

### Activity 2 — Label a River Diagram.

Children label a simple river diagram with source, tributary, course, and mouth.

### Activity 3 — Rivers Near Me.

Children find out the name of a river near their own city or state and discuss how it's used.
