## NCERT Solutions for Class 5 Maths Chapter 4: We the Travellers — II – Free PDF Download

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Chapter 4 of Class 5 Maths Mela, We the Travellers -- II, continues the travel theme from Chapter 1, using road-trip and shopping scenarios to practise addition and subtraction of larger numbers with regrouping.

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### What this chapter teaches.

Adding and subtracting larger numbers (often 4-digit) with regrouping (carrying over and borrowing); solving multi-step word problems involving fuel costs, ticket prices, souvenir shopping, and mountain-trip expenses; estimating totals before calculating exactly; and spotting even-odd number patterns along the way.

### Activity 1 — Plan a Road Trip.

Children are given distances and fuel costs for a journey and must add up the total cost, practising multi-digit addition with regrouping.

### Activity 2 — Shopping for Souvenirs.

Given a budget and a list of souvenir prices, children add up costs and subtract from the budget to find what's left, practising both operations together.

### Activity 3 — Mountain Climb Word Problems.

Problems about climbing to a certain height and coming back down combine addition, subtraction, and estimation skills.

## Why This Chapter Matters

Real-world money and distance problems like these are exactly the kind of multi-step reasoning children will use throughout school and daily life.

## How to Use These Solutions
