Characteristics of Living Things

Q: State two common characteristics of living things.

A: (1) Living things respire — they break down food to release energy. (2) Living things grow, and reproduce to produce offspring similar to themselves.

Plants and Animals Are Both Living

Q: How are plants and animals both living, even though they look very different?

A: Even though plants and animals look very different, both show the basic characteristics of living things — such as respiration, growth, taking in nutrition, excretion, and reproduction — which is why both are classified as living things.
